## HOW TO GET TO THE BEACH

Here is some information about transport and how to get there. The easiest way is to get the **tram line 3**, **direction Pérols - Étang de l'Or.** You need to get off at the very last stop.

There are some local buses connecting this tram stop with the beach, but they are not very frequent. There is the <u>LIGNE 1 Palavas - Étang de l'Or</u> or the <u>Ligne 4 La Grande Motte et Carnon</u>. These buses belong to a different local company and you will have to pay an additional 1€ ticket when you get on. Until the end of June, these lines run on an early summer schedule, with buses every 30 minutes or 1 hour - depending on the day and hour. Here you can find the detailed timetables for <u>line 1</u> and <u>line 4</u>.


The easiest way is to walk from the tram stop Étang del'Or to the nearest beaches, it takes about 30 minutes of foot (3km). You have two beaches nearby:

- **1 Carnon Center / Beachvolley**: it is in Carnon, a little village with restaurants, cafés, and a small port for boats.
- **2 Palavas Les Roquilles**: between Carnon and Palavas. The village of Palavas with all restaurants is about 4 km away, so you will have the beach but less amenities nearby (Palavas is 4km away). You won't be able to join Carnon from this side, walking on the beach.

I attached two maps to give you an idea of the walking routes from the tram to the beach - both Carnon and Palavas Roquilles.

Please consider that all together it takes about 1 hour and 20 minutes to get to the beach this way, from the city center - same thing back.
